Mr. Dennis Biddick assumed the position of Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Navy for Infrastructure Strategy and Analysis on 8 January 2007. In this position Mr. Biddick is charged with providing leadership and guidance for the overall basing and infrastructure requirements analysis and the strategic sourcing program for the Department. He ensures continuity of support for these efforts to the Secretary of the Navy, Chief of Naval Operations, and Commandant of the Marine Corps to achieve long term objectives.

Prior to assuming this position, Mr. Biddick spent just over a year with Fluor Corporation as an operations/program manager for their government group. Fluor is one of the largest engineering, procurement, construction and maintenance contractors in the country. From December 2003 to December 2005, he was the Chief of Staff for the Infrastructure Analysis Team for BRAC 2005.

In September 2003, Mr. Biddick completed a 27 plus-year Navy career as he retired as a Captain in the Civil Engineer Corps. His last assignment on active duty was as the Commanding Officer of the Navy Public Works Center, Washington D.C. as well as the Regional Engineer for Naval District Washington. From September 1999 to September 2001, Mr. Biddick served at Headquarters, Naval Facilities Engineering Command as the Director for Strategic Sourcing.

From March 1997 to September 1999, he was the Executive Officer for the Naval Construction Battalion Center, Port Hueneme, CA heading the efforts to regionalize that installation with NAS Pt Mugu to eventually form Naval Base Ventura County. From August 1993 to March 1997, Mr. Biddick was a senior analyst on the Base Structure Analysis Team for the BRAC 1995 and then the Assistant Head for the OPNAV Base Closure Implementation Office. Prior to that assignment, he was the Resident Officer in Charge of Construction for the Navy's newest homeport, Naval Station, Everett, WA.

Mr. Biddick's other assignments have included: Acquisition Head for Navy Public Works Center, San Diego, CA; Staff Civil Engineer/Public Works Officer for Naval Training Center, San Diego, CA; Contracts Instructor, Civil Engineer Corps Officer School, Port Hueneme, CA; Assistant Resident Officer in Charge of Construction, Charleston, SC; Company Commander, Naval Mobile Construction Battalion FIVE, Port Hueneme, CA; Shore Facilities Planning Officer, Navy Public Works Center, Yokosuka, Japan.

Mr. Biddick holds a Bachelors degree in Civil Engineering from Villanova University and a Masters in Civil Engineering from Penn State University. He has been a certified Acquisition Professional and is a registered Professional Engineer in the State of California.
